Notes: The Wanderers (sports) Club was founded on the 18th August 1888 in Johannesburg. From this grew an athletics section with the assistance of Llewellyn Andersson the South Africa Amateur Athletic Association was formed with Abe Bailey at president. The first Championship Meeting was held at the Wanderers Grounds in March 1894.
