Obverse: Old-head bust of Queen Victoria, left, veiled and diademed. Signed: "I WALKER" on the truncation. Legend above: "VICTORIA.DEI GRA.BRITT." and below: "1900".

Reverse: Monogram: "VR" on shield. Crown on Bible above, laurel wreath around, "IRELAND" on a ribbon below. Legend on a raised pebbled band: "IN COMMEMORATION OF QUEEN VICTORIA'S VISIT TO".

Notes: Queen Victoria visited the city of Dublin in Ireland during the month of April 1900. There she paid tribute to the valour of the Irishmen who were fighting in the Boer War. She was then 80 years old and died the following year.
