Reverse: Beaded border round the rim. Within a garter: "HONI.SOIT.QVI MAL.Y. PENSE", shields of England, Scotland and Ireland arranged in triangular form with thistle, rose and shamrock between and crown at the top. In small letters at the bottom of garter: "L.CHR.LAUER, NUREMBERG". Legend outside: "GREAT BRITAIN.IRELAND.CANADA.AUSTRALIA.SOUTH AFRICA.INDIA".
