Form: Circular. Metal shell over cardboard. Pierced for a suspension ring through a bar which clamps onto a red-white-blue ribbon.

Edge: Upright reeded.

Obverse: Within a beaded border round the rim, conjoined crowned and robed busts of the King and Queen, left. Signed: "H.G." Legend: "KING GEORGE V (left) QUEEN MARY (right)".

Reverse: Within a beaded circle, across: "WITH / HARVEY, GREENACRE / & Co.'s / COMPLIMENTS". Legend, outside the beaded circle and within a beaded border round the rim, above: "TO COMMEMORATE THEIR MAJESTIES CORONATION" and between five-pointed stars: "1911".

Notes: Harvey, Greenacre & Company was established in the 1890s as drapers, outfitters and general importers. They owned an emporium in West Street, Durban.
