Reverse: Across: "TO / COMMEMORATE / THE BIRTH CENTENARY / ?? OF ?? / JOSEPH CHAMBERLAIN / 1836 ? 1936 / "?

Notes: Joseph Chamberlain (1836 – 1914) was a British politician and Colonial Secretary during the Anglo-Boer War.

One year after the issue of this medal, Joseph Chamberlain's son, Neville, became Prime Minister of the United Kingdom.
