Obverse: Uniformed bust of Baden-Powell wearing hat, front. Legend on a raised band above: "THE HERO OF MAFEKING" and between small flowers: "COLNL. BADEN POWELL"

Reverse: Across with Queen's crown at the top: "RELIEF / OF / MAFEKING / 1900". Legend above divided by the crown: "MAY (18TH.(right))" and below: "BESIEGED 218 DAYS". Signed: "SALE (left) BIRM (right)".

Notes: The obverse of this medal is the the same as the reverse of Laidlaw 0282.
