**Edge:** Plain.

**Obverse:** Soldiers on parade while the British flag is being hoisted. Cannon firing on the left. Huts and tents behind. Legend above "SALISBURY" and below: "13 . 9 . 1890".

**Reverse:** Within an outline map of Rhodesia, across: "RHODESIA / CENTENARY / COMMEMORATION / 12.9.1990". Signed: "PAGLIARI" at the foot.

**Notes:** The British South Africa Company formally occupied Mashonaland on 13 September 1890.

The obverse design is taken from a drawing in the publication: 'The British South Africa Company Historical Catalogue & Souvenir of Rhodesia, Empire Exhibition, Johannesburg, 1936–37. It shows the Pioneer Column in full dress parade and the British flag being hoisted by Lieutenant Edward Tyndale-Biscoe at Fort Salisbury. The site became the future Rhodesia Salisbury (now Harare in Zimbabwe).
