Obverse: Conjoined busts of Queen Victoria, diademed and veiled and King Edward VII, crowned. Both left, Queen in front. Legend with curved underlines: "KING EDWARD VII QUEEN VICTORIA".

Reverse: A cartouche for the recipient's name. Across, above: "PRESENTED (in an arc) / TO" and below: "BY / THE SUBSCRIBERS OF / WORKSOP (in an arc)". Legend on a raised pebbled band above: "TO COMMEMORATE SERVICES RENDERED IN SOUTH AFRICA" and below between stops: "1899 TO 1902"

Notes: The example here is unnamed.
