Obverse: Within a laurel wreath tied at the bottom, dove flying right over sea with rising sun on horizon, above in an arc: "PEACE"

Reverse: Between the outline of half-circles above and below, across: "5TH. AUG. / 1919". Legend above: "DISTRIC OF" and b between stops: "PEDDIE".

Notes: Peddie is a town in the Eastern Cape province of South Africa situated 55km south-west of King William's Town and 67 of Grahamstown. It developed from a frontier post established in 1835 and named Fort Peddie, named after Lieutenant John Peddie who led the 72nd Highlanders against the Xhosa in the Sixth Frontier War.
