**Form:** Circular holed at 12 o'clock for a ring

**Edge:** Plain.

**Obverse:** Barehead of King George V, left (similar to coinage).

**Reverse:** Within a wreath of laurel (left) and a palm frond (right), a shield: "MEYERTON (stamped in an arc) / . 1919 . (in an arc)". Superimposed above, a banner: "TO COMMEMORATE THE / VICTORIOUS CONCLUSION / OF THE GREAT WAR".

**Notes:** Meyerton is a small town lying 15 km north of Vereeniging in Gauteng Province, founded in 1891 and named after Johan Petrus Meyer, a field cornet in the Transvaal Volksraad.
