The Johannesburg Festival was organised to celebrate the 70th anniversary the founding of the city in 1886.

It is recorded in AM2 that 850 medals were issued to Whites. It is also recorded AM2 #343 that 600 similar medals with pierced lug for suspension were issued to Blacks.
