Form: Circular with two attached lugs for link rings to a pair of lugs on an ornate suspension pin-back bar inscribed: "OUR / QUEEN AND (diagonal) HEROES".

Edge: Plain.

Obverse: In the centre within a circular beaded border, old-head bust of Queen Victoria, right. Around her, the busts of six generals, separated by ornamental lines between them, each named below the bust. Clockwise from the top left: "ROBERTS", "BULLER", "FRERE", "GATACRE", "KITCHENER" and "WHITE".

Reverse: Royal coat of arms with motto: "DIEU ET MON DROIT".

Notes: Similar medals with different reverses: Laidlaw 0570b & 0570c.
