**Edge:** Plain.

**Obverse:** Within a beaded border round the rim, bareheaded bust of Kruger, left (as on Z.A.R. coinage). Not signed on the truncation. Legend: "S.J. PAUL (left) KRÜGER (right)".

**Reverse:** Beaded border round the rim. Otherwise blank.

**Notes:** Made in Germany for issue in the Z.A. Republic. Similar to Laidlaw 615a, 615b and 615c. Most of these medals have small marks on the reverse for a pin, now removed.

Hern, following AM, believes that these medals were made during the Boer War.
