Reverse: Royal coat of arms with lion and unicorn supporters and motto: "DIEU ET MON DROIT". Legend: "H.G.M EDWARD VII OF GREAT BRITAIN AND EMPEROR OF INDIA CROWNED 1902." Royal cypher: "ER VII" at the foot.
