Edge: Plain.

Obverse: Old-head bust of Queen Victoria, left. Signed: "FENWICK. F." on truncation. Small wreath of rose, thistle and shamrock. Legend on a raised band above: "TO COMMEMORATE THE 60 YEAR REIGN OF H.M.G.M. QUEEN VICTORIA" and between stops: "1837-1897".

Reverse: Within a wreath of the national flows of Great Britain, across: "VICTORIA. E. I / BORN 24 MAY 1819 / ASCENDED 20 JUNE 38 / MARRIED 10 FEB 40 / JUBILEE 1887 / SEXAGENARY (in an arc) / 1897 (in an arc)". At the top of the wreath, the Star of India. On the wreath, shields with the coat of arms of Empire territories each named on a ribbon: top clockwise: "AUSTRALIA", "N. ZEALAND", "GREAT BRITAIN", "CANADA", "C. COLONY".

Notes: Laidlaw 0010a and 0010b are similar medals.
