Edge: Plain.

Obverse: Conjoined bare heads of the King and Queen, he in uniform, left. Legend: "THEIR MOST GRACIOUS MAJESTIES EDWARD VII & ALEXANDRA".

Reverse: Crowned arms of Great Britain with motto: "HONI.SOIT.QUE.MAL.Y.PENSE" on a garter around. Four colonial shields on ribbons around: India (left), Australia (right), Cape Colony (lower right) and Canada (lower left). In the angles below the ribbons: "GOD SAVE THE KING". Garland of rose, thistle and shamrock at the bottom. Legend on a raised band outside beaded border: "BORN NOV 9 1841 ASCENDED JAN 22 1901 CROWNED JUNE 26 1902". Stop at the foot.

Notes: Laidlaw 0517a and 0517b have the same reverse.
