Above on a ribbon with red background: "WAR VETERANS ASSOCIATION". Legend above on orabackground: "SOUTH AFRICAN". Below across on blue background: "1899-1902".

Reverse: Blank. Fastening for a lapel. Stamped: "FENWICK / BIRM".

Notes: The South African War Veterans Association was formed in Guildford in 1929. Its branches provided an opportunity for ex-servicemen to remain in contact and organised support for war veterans in distress and their dependants.
